

SET-UP INSTRUCTIONS

for K&M microphone stands

Design: solo stand - folding feet - extendable stand tubes - with boom arm

MODEL

FEATURES

Versatile microphone stand complete with boom arm.
High-quality workmanship, stability, flexibility, and durability.
As a compact package, it is ideal for touring.

Example model designation: 21090-300-55

21090 = Model no. (short number)

-300 = Code for 3/8"-BSW thread

-500 = Code for 5/8"-UNS-27G thread

-02 = chrome-plated surfaces

-55 = black surfaces (powder-coated)

-87 = basalt gray surfaces (powder-coated)

Base: Bell-shaped base (zinc or PA) with three folding feet

Stand: Base tube and extension tube

- or base tube, extension tube, and end tube

Infinitely variable locking of the height using:

- Clamping sleeve

- or clamp with knurled screw

- or one-hand clutch

Threaded bolt (BSW-3/8", UNS-5/8"-27G) for:

- Microphone / boom arm / gooseneck

Boom arm: One-piece or extendable

Infinitely variable adjustment and locking of the:

Extension (range) and inclination (+90°/-90°)

With threaded bolt (BSW-3/8", UNS-5/8"-27G)

Material: Base stand and boom arm tubes: steel

Swivel joint: steel/PA

Base, swivel head: die-cast zinc / PA

Thread: steel, galvanized

Grips, bushings: PA

Parquet protector: TPE

Load capacity: max. 1 kg, microphones only

SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

The stability of the stand depends largely on:

a. **LOAD CAPACITY:** only microphones up to 1 kg

b. **SURFACE:** must be level and load-bearing

c. **EXTERNAL ENVIRONMENT:** protect from wind and unwanted tampering

d. **ADJUSTMENT** of a boom arm: via one of the legs

- The possibility of folding or moving the product naturally involves a risk of entrapment; careful and attentive handling during assembly, operation, and disassembly is therefore essential.

- Occasionally tighten the thread (tighten firmly but do not overtighten).

- For cleaning, use a slightly damp cloth and a non-abrasive cleaning agent.

- Parquet protectors are free of plasticizers as far as possible:
To protect particularly sensitive floors, a non-slip carpet pad should be used if necessary.

INSTRUCTIONS

BASE

- Open feet **1**,

- Loosen base screw **2**,

- Pull out base tube **3** as far as it will go,

- Re-tighten base screw **2**.

STAND

- Slightly loosen the clamping sleeve/knurled screws **4**,
or press together the one-hand clutch

- Bring the extension tube **5** to the desired height

- Release the one-hand clutch, or

- re-tighten the clamping sleeve/knurled screws **4**
(DO NOT OVERTURN - hand tight is completely sufficient)

BOOM ARM

- Screw the swivel arm (swivel head, **6**) onto the extension tube of the stand

- Lock position with knurled washer **7** if necessary (see position **12**)

INCLINATION - Loosen clamping nut **7**

- Move boom arm **8** to the desired position

- Re-tighten clamping nut **7**

EXTENSION - Loosen knurled screw(s) **9**

- Extend or retract boom arm **10**

- Re-tighten knurled screw(s) **9**

DIRECTION - Turn the swivel arm **11** in the desired direction

(the clamping sleeve **4** does not need to be loosened)

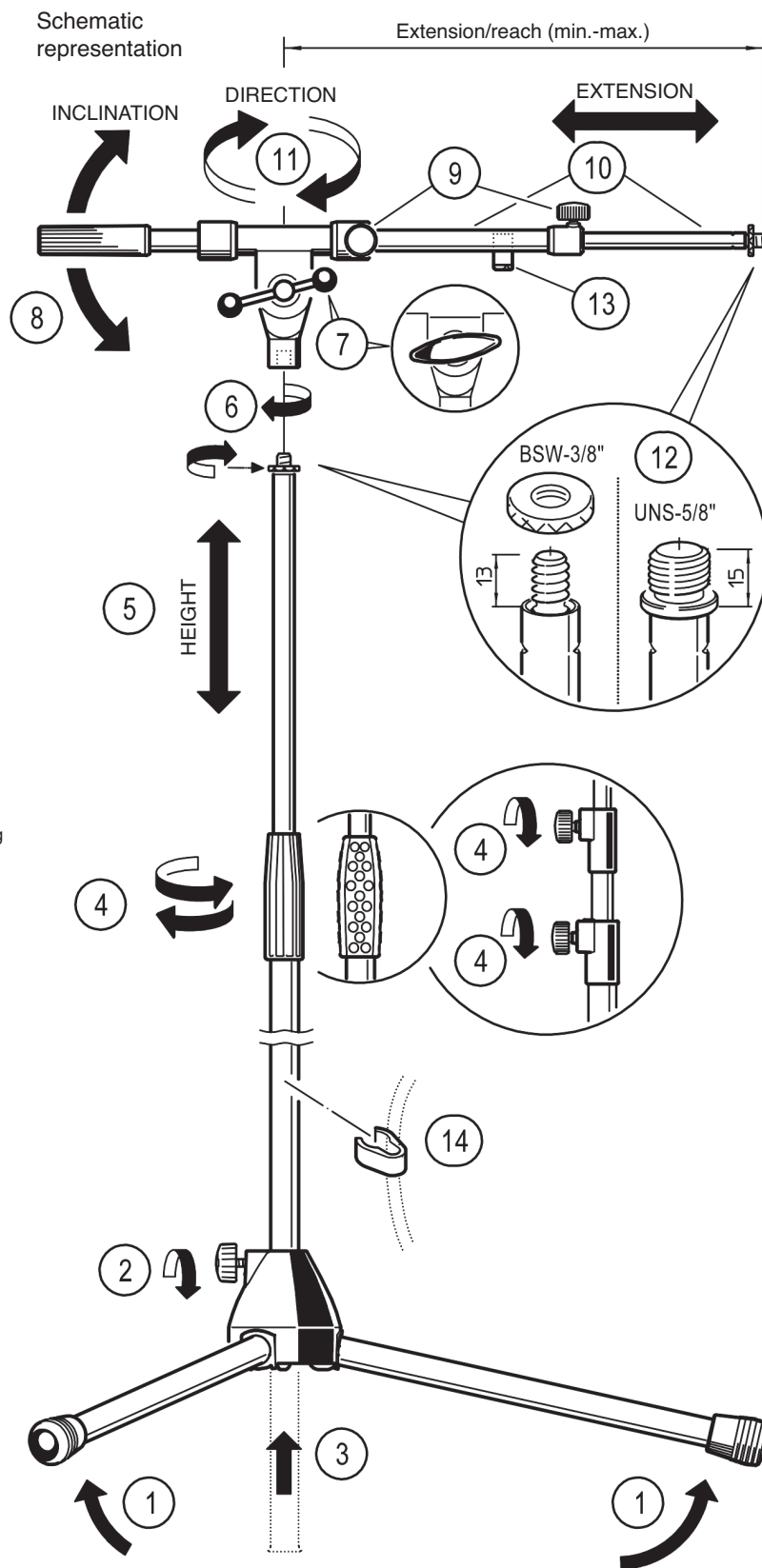
MICROPHONE

- The connection thread **12** is available in two versions:

- 3/8"-BSW (with loose lock nut/knurled washer)

- 5/8"-UNS-27G (with integrated stop)

- There are cable clamps **13**, **14** on the boom arm and stand tube



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
